

# TRINITY INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

**TIU POLICY:** Facilities Use Policy

**TIU POLICY #:** P-607

**STATUS:** Approved, August 2016

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## **I. PURPOSE:**

To specify policy regarding the use of facilities in coordination with the mission and stated beliefs of Trinity International University (University).

## **II. SCOPE:**

This policy applies to all University real estate including any land, buildings, athletic fields or other structures available for use.

## **III. POLICY:**

### **A. University Mission**

All facilities use, whether by internal or external persons or groups, should relate to the educational and/or religious purpose of the University.

### **B. Religious Programming**

Groups or persons providing programming, activities or other content of a religious nature must certify that the content not be in conflict with the [EFCA Statement of Faith](#).

### **C. Content Disclosure**

All anticipated program content must be disclosed to the University in advance of approval of the facilities use. The requested use must not be in conflict with the Policies of the University, including in particular the University's prohibition of alcohol on campus.

### **D. Facilities Use Request and Contract**

No use request is final until memorialized in an Event Services Contract signed by the Lessee and the Lessor.

### **E. Private Use**

All private use of University facilities must be requested through the Events Services team. Facilities are not available for private use apart from Event Services.
