TIU POLICY: Authority of Security Personnel Policy

I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the law enforcement authority of Campus Safety and Security personnel.

II. SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Trinity International University (University) Campus Safety and Security personnel.

III. POLICY:

Safety and Security Services has a No Arrest/No Detainment policy. Officers are required to observe and report any criminal or suspicious behavior to the Bannockburn Police Department, as well as report any violations of University policies to the appropriate Student Life personnel.

The University has a memorandum of understanding with the Village of Bannockburn for support in emergencies and assistance with the University Emergency Operations Plan. The University also receives Village emergency alerts.

The Bannockburn Police Department provides the University with an annual crimes statistic report form for any crimes adjacent to the University within a specified areas as defined by the Clery geography. The Bannockburn Police Department is also encouraged to patrol the University campus and is the lead investigator for any crime on campus.
